Useful Information For your photo sitting

Capturing your memories are all that matters and we want to try to make your images as perfect as possible. Children are never the same for a photo shoot. Our aim is to capture their personality in our images. Below are just suggestions.

Tidbits

1. Simplicity (not a lot of props)
2. Coats and Hats can be interesting.
3. Let the kids be natural don't press them.
4. For a girl a flower/Gerber daisy is a nice touch, let the child pick out their own whenever possible, this allows them to be more attached to it.
5. Timeless outfits for children (an outfit that will look the same in almost any time period.
6. Avoid whites (*hard to hold detail*), stripes, patterns ,Ultra bright colors.
7. Sometimes even if it breaks the rules have the child pick-out/wear their favorite cloths.
8. If the child has a favorite toy, doll, teddy bear, bring it.

This sitting is important to you, but also important to me. If I feel that it wasn't the child's day (you all know about that), or that I as well as you are dissatisfied with the results. You will be welcome to return during one of our scheduled days at no cost.
